

Wet on Wet White

General

Wet on Wet White is a water base printing paste where used to achieve an elastic, soft touching and white covering effect in textile printing. Does not dry during the print and block the screen.

Advantages

- If used correctly as advised, It does not dry during the print and block in the silk-screen.
- It provides elastic and soft textureeffect with excellent coverage.
- Wet on Wet White has extremely wash fastness.
- It is fixed at (280°F-302 °F /140°C – 150 °C) , 2 – 2.5 mins ; (320°F-340 °F 160°C-170°C) , 1,5 – 2 mins.
- Suitable to ecological standards.
- Rubbing and washing tests should be applied 24 hours after curing.

Applications

- Wet on Wet White has been manufactured for elastic and proper surface printings.
- Before use, please stir the product well.
- Do not use any additives that are not advised.
- After using, the silk-screen should be cleaned with water.

Usage

- It provides to print with the silk-screen that are made between 62-77 mm mesh 60-70 Shore, U type should be used.
- It can be mixed with Wet on Wet Clear in any ratio

Storage & Shelf Life

- Keep containers dry and tightly closed. Store in a ventilated place between (+5)-(+30)°C /(+41)-(+86)°F of temperature.
- It should be consumed within 2 years after the production date.
